It is a unique opportunity for a Dalcroze teacher to be truly immersed in the world of teaching Dalcroze for all ages with families and students who value all that Dalcroze can do to enrich their lives, instrumental studies, and joyful learning. It also includes working with a diverse team of wonderful educators who truly care for all that Dalcroze can do to support individuals, families, and communities!

This position includes in-person instruction in Louisville and Longmont, Colorado and may include some online teaching if desired/when necessary. It will have in-person and online mentoring and training to familiarize the teacher with programs, students, and Integral Steps' mission.

We are looking for a teacher to fill a current class schedule for the 2022-2023 Academic Year. Preferred start date in December (training/mentoring/shadowing current teacher) to take over classes fully in January.
